ANDREWS CUP FOR SPINNERS

Award for beginner spinners or those who have never won an award before.
A skein of wool approximately 50 grams

ANDREWS CUP FOR WEAVERS

Award for beginner weavers or those who have never won an award before.
A length of woven cloth in any fibre, please state proposed use.
Or a small item made from your weaving.

BURFORD TROPHY

Award for weaving
A woven length of cloth, please state intended use of material and give details of the technique and yarn used
Minimum length 1 metre

HARLEY TROPHY

Award for creative weaving
A creative weaving of a textured/tactile nature, using any method of weaving.

GREYFRIARS PLATE

Award for dyeing
Hand dyed with vibrant colour(s), a skein of yarn or piece of cloth in any fibre.
Please state dye and mordant used, minimum 25 grams

PHYLL PEACOCK SHIELD

Award for spinning
A hand spun skein of any fibre spun on a spindle or method other than a flyer wheel.
Please state the method of spinning and proposed use of the yarn. Approximately 50 grams

THE TONY WILLIAMS AWARD

Award for excellence in weaving
A length of handwoven cloth, please state intended use.
Design, use of colour and techniques will be taken into consideration.

MILLENNIUM CUP

Award for a finished item
A hand spun knitted or crochet garment
An original colour combination or design

NEW FOREST GUILD CUP

Award for a finished item
A hand spun knitted or crochet accessory such as a shawl, hat, scarf, gloves etc.

BONUS COMPETITION

Longest thread spun in 5 minutes from the given fibre on the guild day.
Start of the spinning must be marked with a tied contrasting thread.
Yarn will be measured as the longest length of continuous single.
Fibre prize.
